Activities to be carried out throughout Global Money Week in schools and continuing until April 2026

1	Setting up stands within school premises by teachers in cooperation with their students, where various activities related to this year's Global Money Week theme will take place.
2	Assigning and carrying out small research projects on current economic issues, linking Economics lessons with developments in the global and Cypriot economies.
3	Creative projects by students to highlight financial education topics, such as creating a Global Money Week poster, a poster or wall calendar, a board or digital game, a video, etc.
4	Organising cross-curricular and interdisciplinary activities involving teachers from different subject areas, including Economics, Technology, Information Technology, Art, Mathematics, Languages and Home Economics.
5	Organising student visits to places such as the Central Bank of Cyprus Monetary Museum, the Cyprus Stock Exchange, the Museum of the History of Cypriot Coinage, banks, local businesses, etc.
6	Using newspaper articles or excerpts from news bulletins on economic issues as material for classroom discussion during Economics lessons.
7	Submitting details of the activities, together with photographic material, for publication on the Global Money Week website.
8	Using the children's book "70 Toko and a Hole in the Shoe" by Maria Loizidou. The activities linked to the story focus on fundamental concepts such as income and expenses, budgeting and saving.
